Terms of Use

The following are the terms of use for carpool-designated parking spots, helping make your bus, metro or commuter train transfers quicker and easier.

Your Daily Commitments

When parking your vehicle in a designated carpool spot, don't forget to follow these rules:

- There must be at least two people aged 16 or over in the vehicle when you are parking
- Your vehicle must be parked in a spot that is designated for carpoolers

Benefits

- It's practical: you always have a parking spot close to public transit services.
- It's free: you can park at no charge in an available designated spot.
- It's flexible: you can ride with whomever you want, whenever you want.
- It's economical: you can choose to split your car usage costs with you carpool partners.
- It's ecological: carpooling helps reduce your greenhouse gas emissions and ecological footprint.

KEEP IN MIND...

First Come, First Served

There are no reserved spaces. Therefore, it's possible that all spots will be taken when you arrive. In that case, you can use another spot in the park-and-ride lot.

On Your Own?

On days when you're riding alone, you are no longer allowed to park in designated carpool spaces. You must then park elsewhere in the park-and-ride lot.
